Ticket Details – The Emirates FA Cup

Stadium Arrangements

We are delighted that our game has been chosen to be screened live on BT Sport, and are working with our local authority, the London Borough of Hillingdon, our friends at Oxford United and the local police to finalise arrangements for ensuring a safe environment for all supporters at the stadium on the day.

These discussions continue and are likely to be concluded during the coming week. As a result, our final capacity at the SkyEx Community Stadium is being reviewed, and we hope to be able to confirm actual ticket numbers at that point.

Stadium Modifications

As a result of having to segregate supporters, new infrastructure is being commissioned to make this work, and to put in place something that can be used as a permanent feature for future seasons. The main stand 'self-segregates', so physical infrastructure is only needed around the tunnel area and behind the dugouts. As a result, it is likely that there will be a 50/50 split on capacity with Oxford United for this reason. Home fans will enter via the usual turnstiles, with Away fans through the dedicated turnstiles at the Beaconsfield Road end of the ground.

Additional toilet facilities are being procured both in the segregated area and outside the bar to ease use on a match day, along with additional food outlets.

Ticketing arrangements

We have set the ticket prices at:

Adults £15.00 Concessions (Over 60 and Students 16-22 with iD) £10.00 Under 16s £5.00

Seated tickets will be sold as unreserved, but within each block of seating – This is to ensure that we do not oversell any particular area – The block for each seat will be denoted on the ticket, and the blocks in the stand similarly. Home areas are Blocks A, B, C, D and away areas are blocks E, F, G, H. Due to the high anticipated demand, and our requirements to provide the FA and other institutions with tickets, we cannot guarantee which blocks will go on sale first. Once all seated tickets are sold, the remaining tickets will be STANDING only, and will be in the designated areas for home and away supporters (Home at the 3G end, away at the Beaconsfield Road end).

Tickets will go on sale on **Saturday 2nd November** at our game with Blackfield & Langley. They will be allocated as follows:

**Season Ticket Holders
Attendee @ Blackfield & Langley**

Maximum 4 tickets per season ticket holder

Anyone attending the game against Blackfield & Langley that is not a Season Ticket holder can buy 2 tickets per ticket holder

The Season Ticket holder benefit will expire after the close of business on Sunday 3rd November, and depending on the number of tickets available, will go on General Sale on Monday 4th November, with details on how to get the tickets at that time.

Online Ticket Sales

Initially ticket sales will only be done through personal collection at the ground. However, subject to numbers of tickets available after the initial priority arrangements, an online portal through the club shop may be offered. However, tickets will have to be collected from the ground prior to the match, and will NOT be available for collection on the match day.
